\*Students who did not complete a postsecondary programme in ECE before admission to the BA(ECFS) programme are required to study a 3-cp bridging course, PSY2096 Child Development.

\*Mandatory Greater Bay Area activities in course(s) are required.

\*Students admitted into this programme are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Chinese Mainland. The programme may also require students to participate in other non-local learning experience for completion of the programme. While the visits are subsidised, students are required to contribute part of the estimated cost of the visits ("students' contribution"), whereas any personal entertainment, meals expenses, travel document fee and personal insurance costs shall be at students' own expense. The estimated cost of the visits and students' contribution for students admitted to the coming cohort is yet to be available due to a variety of factors such as inflation of cost of the visits, trip duration, traveling expenses, the exchange rate, etc.




### 3 Programme Features



# Admission Requirement



- Applicants holding a **recognized post-secondary qualification** such as an Associate Degree / Higher Diploma, preferably in early childhood studies or related discipline; or
- **Transfer students** who have completed at least two years of study of a 4-year full time degree programme in a recognized institution, preferably in early childhood studies or related discipline; or
- **Mature applicants** (aged 25 or above on 31 August of the year in which applicants commence their studies) who have specific talents, achievements or a wealth of relevant experience; or
- **Other equivalent qualifications to be assessed on an individual basis.**

- Interviews will be arranged with applicants on a selective basis.


