Double Degree of BA(ESDC)&BEd(EL)

156 credit points in 5 years of study

Receive training to teach in both primary and secondary schools with a study of focus (i.e. primary or secondary level) assigned

There are two majors, namely, Education Major and Discipline Studies Major:

- Education Major focuses on theories and practices in English language teaching. It will cover both primary and secondary school settings.
- Discipline Studies Major is about Linguistics, Phonology, Literature, Information Technology, etc.

- Develop a wider worldview




Internship

- Students will be joining a compulsory and creditbearing internship programme in Year 4 Summer Semester
- Approximately 120 hours
- Providing students with working experiences outside the classrooms and diversifying students' career pathways



Visit to Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Mainland China

- Students admitted to this programme are required to visit the Greater Bay Area (GBA) and/or other parts of Mainland China.
- Programme may also require students to participate in other non-local learning experience for completion of the programme. While the visits are heavily subsidised, students are still required to contribute part of the estimated cost of the visits.

- The 2025/26 academic year marks the first cohort of the BA(ESDC) & BEd(EL) programme. Employment survey data is currently unavailable.
- For reference, data from the double degree of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Language Studies & Bachelor of Education (Honours) (English Language) shows that 95.5% of employed graduates are working in the education sector (including both teaching and non-teaching positions). The average initial monthly salary of full-time locally employed graduates was HK\$34,751.

Entrance Requirements

Applicants who possess the following qualifications are welcome to apply via the non-JUPAS route:

- Associate Degree/Higher Diploma students or graduates (including those who will obtain such a qualification by August in the year in which admission is sought)
- Non-local Qualifications
- ■Transfer Students who are currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or higher degree programme at a recognised local or non-local university
- HKALE Qualification
- Mature Applicants

HKALE	Grade E or above in ASL Use of English
HKDSE	Level 3 or above in English Language Level 2 or above in English Language (applicable to holders of a recognized AD/HD)
GCE System	Grade E or above in GCE AS-level or A-level English; or Grade C / Grade 4 or above in IGCSE / GCE O-level English; or Grade C / Grade 4 or above in GCSE English or English Literature
IB	English A: Language and Literature (Higher or Standard Level) – Grade 4; or English A: Literature (Higher or Standard Level) – Grade 4; or English B (Higher Level) – Grade 4; or English B (Standard Level) – Grade 5; or English Literature and Performance (Standard Level) – Grade 4; or English Text and Performance (Standard Level) – Grade 4
IELTS Academic	Overall Band: 6 (the test should be taken in test centres and the result should be valid within two years after the test date)

TOEFL (within 2 years after the test date)	Internet-based Test (iBT): 80^; or Paper-based (prior to July 2017): 550; or Paper-delivered Test: A sum score of 60 * TOEFL ITP and MyBestTM Score are not accepted (the test should be taken in test centres and the result should be valid within two years after the test date).

Others	Other Chinese language qualifications deemed acceptable by the University
