

General Entrance Requirement

Students from all backgrounds are all welcome.

- Graduates of Associate Degree/ Higher Diploma from a recognised institutions with a good GPA; or
- Final year students of a recognised Associate
 Degree/ Higher Diploma programme or
 equivalent* (subject to successful completion of
 the programme by August with a good GPA)
- Transfer students who are currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or higher degree programme (considered on an individual basis)

- Fulfil one of the following English Language
 Requirements:
 - Level 3 or above in HKDSE English Language; or
 - Level 2 or above in HKDSE English Language (applicable to holders of recognised AD/HD); or
 - Overall score of IELTS 6.0 (Academic version); or
 - TOEFL score of 80 (Internet-based); or
 - Passing the TOEFL ITP does not satisfy the English Language Requirement
 - MyBest Score is not accepted
- Pass the Admission Interview
